**DISCHARGING FIREWORKS**

(City Code 15-9 b)

**Fireworks may be discharged within the City limits on:**

**New Years Eve - 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 Midnight**

**New Years Day - 12:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m.**

**July 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> - 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 Midnight**

**It Shall be Unlawful to:**

1 Discharge fireworks on private property unless permission has been obtained from the owner.

2 Throw or discharge fireworks from a motor vehicle whether such vehicle is moving or standing still.

3 Discharge fireworks within 100 feet of any gasoline station or storage area where volatile liquids or gasses are dispensed.

4 Discharge any rocket of over four (4) ounces.

Public fireworks displays by organizations are permitted after obtaining a special permit from the Fire Chief.

***\*\* Each Year the governing body of the City of Evanston may designate City property to be used to legally discharge fireworks. \*\****

**2010 Designated areas are:**

**Centennial Valley Parking Lot, Overthrust Ballfields Parking Lots and Paved Areas, Old ECDC Parking Area on Elm Street, and Overthrust Park Parking Lot.**

**The City of Evanston asks that you please clean-up your fireworks after discharging!**
